ITCASS meeting 30th and 31st of August 2012 in Elsinore (Helsingør), Denmark

ITCASS meetings are small and informal meetings that bring together scientists working in the field of immunotoxicology. The aims of these meetings are to enable scientists to present their research in progress, to stimulate discussions between different experts in the field and to enable scientific collaborations within Europe. The 1½ day meeting will cover the following topics: contact and respiratory allergy, drug allergy/autoimmunity, food allergy, alternative testing strategies in the field of immunotoxicology, immunosuppression, and developmental immunotoxicology.

Furthermore, on this meeting the following key note lectures will be presented:

- Erwin Roggen, Novozymes, Denmark: Sensitisation – beyond Sens-it-iv.
- Ian Kimber, University of Manchester, UK: Mechanisms of T-cell regulation in contact sensitisation

The meeting will take place at Konventum (www.konventum.dk). From Copenhagen airport (www.cph.dk) there are direct trains to Elsinore every 20 min (www.rejseplanen.dk). It takes about 1 hour. From Elsinore train station bus 803 goes to Konventum (also called LO-skolen). Taxi from the station is also a possibility.
